

Greetings Fellow Scout:

Congratulations on being elected for candidacy in the Order of the Arrow. Your election demonstrates that you live the Scout Oath and Law in your daily life and serve as an example for the Scouts of your Troop. Election is merely the first step on this journey you are about to undertake. The next step is to attend an induction or "Ordeal" weekend. At this weekend you will face many challenges with your fellow Scouts. After successful completion of your Ordeal, you will become a member of our Lodge. There are three opportunities to complete your Ordeal on the dates listed below. You can register online for your ordeal by going to www.miami495.org. We highly encourage you to register early so you can prepare for your experience.

Spring Ordeal:May 2nd - 4^{th} at Cricket Holler Scout CampSummer Ordeal:August $8^{th} - 10^{th}$ at Cricket Holler Scout CampFall Ordeal:September $26^{th} - 28^{th}$ at Cricket Holler Scout Camp

The cost for participation in an Ordeal is \$85.00. This cost includes your food for the weekend, OA sash, Miami Lodge pocket flap, OA handbook, membership dues for 2025 & 2026, and the cost of your Brotherhood conversion the following year. If these items were purchased separately, it would be \$135.00. Six months after you have been inducted you will be encouraged to seal your membership by undergoing a Brotherhood conversion. Brotherhood conversions are held at every Ordeal. If you go through your Brotherhood conversion prior to the end of 2026, there is no cost. The Brotherhood conversion costs \$35 but is included in the cost of your Ordeal. If you feel you will be unable to afford the cost of the ordeal weekend, please email our Lodge Adviser at drewturner.bsa@gmail.com as financial assistance is available.

Candidates may start checking in for our Ordeals at 8:00pm. Check in for (Spring, Summer and Fall) Ordeals are at Cricket Holler Scout Camp in front of the K Lodge. Scouts and Scouters won't need to bring that much to their Ordeal. Be sure that you do bring everything on the list below, and be mindful of the items you should not bring and leave those at home. What to Bring:

- Class A Uniform
- Sleeping bag / sleeping pad
- Tarp / Ground cloth
- Tent / Hammock (Saturday night only)
- Work clothes / gloves
- Extra change of clothes
- Rain gear
- Water bottle
- Personal Hand Sanitizer
- Flashlight
- BSA Annual Health Records Parts A & B
- Spending money for Lodge Trading Post
- Any needed medication (turned in at check in)

What NOT to Bring:

- Food / Mess kit (please inform us of any special needs)
- Electronics of any kind (watches, phones, tablets, etc.)
- Matches / Lighters

Candidates are expected to stay the entire weekend (Friday – Sunday). Each Ordeal ends with a Lodge meeting typically around 11:30am on Sunday. The exact pick-up time will be communicated during check-in.
